

## **Discovering Australia**K-Adults

**Overview** – Discovering Australia has been specifically designed for students learning English as an additional language. This experience can be modified to suit the student's age and level of English. It is therefore essential to advise these details at the time of booking.

Students are introduced to the diversity of Australian habitats and the incredible animals that live here. The program provides an opportunity for students to learn and practice new vocabulary specific to animals and conservation. The skills of describing, labelling, contrasting and comparing are utilised.

**Lesson Logistics** — Students take part in a fun, interactive experience where they have an opportunity to meet some Australian animals up-close. The hands-on components are supported with PowerPoint slides to provide additional visual images of animals and vocabulary used. Students are welcome to bring their cameras along for this session.

**Duration** – 45 minutes
