



NEED TO KNOW ABOUT GROUP PICNICS, CORPORATE & FAMILY DAYS

Unreserved Areas

If you have not reserved your picnic space, plan to arrive early – remember weekends in December are very popular for Christmas parties. Groups may put up a sign for ease of location, but no advertising of products or balloon clusters please.

Barbecues

Free electric barbecue facilities are available on the Main Lawn and the Walkabout Lawn. They are limited and shared by many users in unreserved spaces. Please be considerate of others.

Catering

Perth Zoo has free BBQ facilities on the Main Lawn.
Please note Perth Zoo does not have the facilities to store birthday cakes.

Entertainment and Games

For the comfort of visitors, animals and staff, amplified sound/music is not allowed in the Zoo without prior permission and we request that the following items are not brought into the Zoo: balls, balloons, ropes, whistles, skateboards, roller blades, frisbees, bikes, tricycles and scooters.

Lockers

We have self-service lockers available for hire (including hamper sized), located at the old train station just inside the Zoo. Lockers are \$6. Please read terms of use and instructions before securing the locker.

Rubbish

Please ensure the beauty of the Zoo grounds is preserved by leaving your area clean and using the bins nearby. Remember: reduce, reuse, recycle.

Smoking

Perth Zoo is a 100% SMOKE FREE environment. Your guests will need to exit the Zoo to have a cigarette or an e-cigarette.

State legislation requires smokers do not smoke within five meters of any government building and within ten meters of any window, air-duct or air-intake. Please respect the health of nearby Zoo visitors when smoking in front of the Zoo.

Strollers And Kids' Wagons

Strollers and towable wagons are available for hire from the Zoo entrance at a cost of \$13 per hire/day. A driver's licence, credit card (or \$50 refundable bond) must be presented for security purposes.

Parking

Paid, timed ticket parking is available on the corner of Labouchere/Richardson Roads, the car parks off Labouchere Road and Mill Point Road next to the Zoo, and in the streets surrounding Perth Zoo. ACROD parking is available at the small Zoo car park adjacent to the traffic lights at the Zoo entry on Labouchere Road and in the Reception Centre car park on Labouchere Road. Both are just a short, flat distance from the Zoo's entry. Limited free street parking is available a few blocks from the Zoo. Unlimited free street parking is available further up Labouchere Road and Bus 30 and 31 stop in front of the Zoo every ten minutes most days.

Wheelchairs

Wheelchairs are available from the Entrance Cashiers at no charge. Some form of identification is required to be presented for security purposes, as well as a \$10 returnable deposit. Bookings are essential. Please call 08 9474 0343 to reserve a wheelchair.

Vehicles

For safety reasons, vehicles are not allowed inside the Zoo. Picnic equipment can be unloaded in the small carpark adjacent to the traffic lights in front of the Zoo and carried in.

Due to demand or unforeseen circumstances, the Zebra Car or wheelchairs may sometimes be unavailable.
