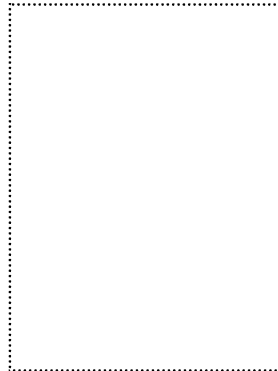
Healthy Habitats

Healthy habitats need lots of living things to keep everything in balance. Think about how these plants and animals help keep a **wetland** healthy.

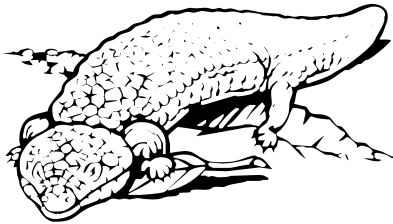
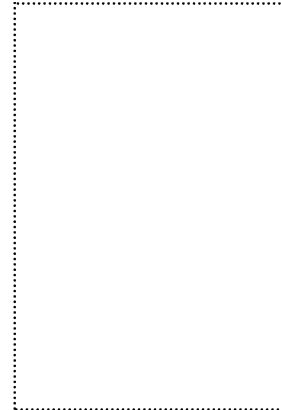

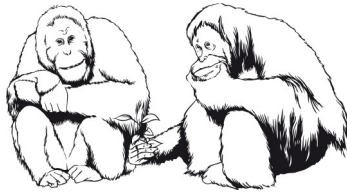
