Your legacy for future generations can be to create a safe and secure future for wildlife well into the future.



#### A Best Friend for Generations



Your thoughfulness will safeguard the important conservation work at a natural heritage institution Western Australians like you hold in their heart.


Your kindness can also support collaboration with partners nationwide to establish and run breeding programs to support the Species Recovery Plans for a range of native animals.

## Safety in the Wild

Do you believe in a world where diversity of species and habitats is secure?

From local breeding programs to international projects, the conservation efforts you believe in span the globe.

Perth Zoo works in partnership with local and global conservation partners to save wildlife and support field-based conservation.

With decades of delivering tangible, long-term outcomes such as protecting and securing natural habitats, funding anti-poaching units, and participating in regional species breeding programs – Perth Zoo's impact is global.

Over 7,000km away Perth Zoo has contributed to a project in Nepal, to protect forests and habitat where Red Pandas are facing local extinction. Closer to home Perth Zoo works with partners to protect the site of one of the last remaining herds of Sumatran Elephants in the world. These are just two of the many examples of Perth Zoo's work in the wild.





### **Educating for the Future**

Perth Zoo is the largest non-school based educator in Western Australia.


From pre-schoolers to tertiary students and older, you can help ensure future generations are educated about:

### **A Living Breathing Site**

Perth Zoo is a rich and diverse botanical estate. As the very first botanical garden in Perth, we have strong roots.


The 41-acre South Perth site contains many rare and critically endangered plant species ensuring Perth Zoo's botanical garden is just as fascinating and in need of your protection as the animals.

The meticulous planning of the gardens was a priority from lune 1897 when the first sod was turned. Countless hours were initially dedicated to creating a botanical haven, and the gardens have been lovingly looked after by our horticulture team since.

The gardens flourished, boasting rose beds, lupin fields, exotic tropical plants, and a majestic collection of 60 palm tree species that still grace our grounds today.

Today, our commitment to botanical excellence remains strong and will remain so with your support. We cultivate our own animal fodder, with hibiscus, bamboo, Fijian Fire Plant, Mirror Plant, and Elephant Grass gracing the menu.

You can ensure landscaping and flora will continue to play a critical role in designing and caring for our gardens, fostering a naturalistic environment for our animals and a captivating experience for our visitors with your thoughtful legacy.







## **All Big Things Start Small**

We never knew the impact Tricia would have when she first arrived at Perth Zoo.

Tricia became the matriarch of her own herd, and a beloved part of thousands of memories.

Throughout her time at Perth Zoo, Tricia saw many changes. Tricia's own enclosure changed from a concrete pen to a new home that was triple the size with a swimming pool, mud wallow, trees, scratching posts, and a heated barn with sand floors and sleeping mounds.

When Perth Zoo opened in 1898 it was a place of recreation and fascination, with cement cages, bars and mesh barriers. Few people are aware that Gifts in the Wills of generous supporters like you have made Perth Zoo a place where the physical, psychological and social needs of animals are met while working towards securing the future of wildlife.

Your legacy is your decision, and we understand your priorities may change during your lifetime. You can choose to change your mind at any time, for any reason. You will always be our friend.


#### **Your Herd**


You can choose to share as much or as little about your Will details as you wish, but we would love the opportunity to thank you now.
